CHARBONIER ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Missouri American Water is investing over \$500 million statewide in 2024 to improve water service in the communities we serve. These investments are critical for maintaining and improving system reliability, resiliency and water quality.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Missouri American Water is replacing approximately 6,000 feet of aging water main dating back to 1962 along Charbonier Road, from Lindbergh to Shackleford, improving service and reliability for area customers. Replacing the old water pipe will significantly reduce the chance of future service disruptions.

FAST FACTS

- Replacement of about 6,000 feet of water pipe originally installed in 1962.
- Missouri American Water's website will be updated with information on all phases of the project.
- Completion is expected in approximately 6–8 months.
- Most work will be Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Sections of the north bound lane will be closed where construction is active. Please check missouriamwater.com > **News & Community > Local Projects** for updated traffic impacts.

TEMPORARY SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS

Water service will be temporarily interrupted to connect water service from the old water pipes to the new ones, and when the new water pipes are connected to the existing water system. Every effort will be made to provide advanced notice to impacted customers.

RESTORATION

For efficiency, restoration crews will begin work following construction crews as sections of new pipe are installed. This project is also being coordinated with county road improvements to minimize traffic impacts.
