**Purpose:**

This advice letter filing is to recover the balance in California American Water's Los Angeles District Water Contamination Litigation Memo Account.

Submission of these tariffs is made per page 98 of the Partial Settlement in Application 09-01-013 between the Division of Ratepayer Advocates and California American Water which states:

RESOLUTION: In rebuttal, California American Water agreed that it should recover the Los Angeles district WRAM/MCBA balance in compliance with the prior settlement agreement, which

calls for recovery within 30 days of the filing of the 2010 annual report, or when the balance reaches 2.5% of revenue. California American Water also agrees that the \$1,000,600 balance in the Los Angeles district water contamination account should be audited prior to recovery. *The Parties agree that the water contamination memorandum account authorized by Resolution W-4528 should not be reevaluated because the Commission had already authorized recovery of that amount. DRA agrees to perform the reasonableness reviews described above before January 1, 2011 [emphasis added].*

**Background:**

On March 26, 1998, Commission approved Resolution W-4094 authorizing all water utilities to establish memorandum accounts to track water contamination litigation expenses.

California American Water's balance for the Los Angeles District's Water Contamination Litigation memo account, from November 29, 2001 to February 28, 2011, is undercollected by a total of \$1,146,053.61. This represents a summation of unrecovered contamination litigation expenses from previously reviewed and approved expenses in Advice Letter 580 as well as expenses that have not been previously reviewed:

Contamination Expenses previously reviewed and unrecovered in Advice Letter 580	\$64,481.73
Contamination Expenses previously not reviewed and unrecovered	<u>\$1,081,571.88</u>
Total Contamination Expenses to be Recovered	\$1,146,053.61

The total undercollected represents 4.28% of the current operating revenues of \$26,773,302 per the approval of Advice Letter 865. According to Standard Practice U-27-W which states, "Reserve and memo account amortization surcharges shall be spread over one year for undercollections of less than 5% of gross revenues" this 4.28% of the current operating revenues is below 5%, therefore the collection period for this surcharge will be 12 months.

California American Water proposes to implement a quantity surcharge of \$0.11560 per ccf on all units consumed by the Los Angeles District for 12 months from the approval of this advice letter filing.

**Request:**

California American Water requests approval of the attached tariffs, which are implementing a surcharge to recover the balance in the Los Angeles District's Water Contamination Litigation memo account which will effect all customers in the Los Angeles District. The surcharge is \$0.11560 per ccf on all units consumed for 12 months from the approval of this advice letter.

**Tier Designation:**

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 2 filing.

**Effective Date:**

California American Water requests that the tariffs discussed above, be made effective June 3, 2011

**Service List:**

**Protest and Responses:**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material errors or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
