TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Purpose:

The purpose of this advice letter is to clarify and designate the Highland Ave Tank Project as the project to be included in the Pressure Reducing Value Modernization and Energy Recovery Memorandum Account authorized by Resolution W-4854 on December 2, 2010. This advice letter supplements Advice Letter 876-A, which the Commission has already approved pursuant to Resolution W-4854.

Background:

In Resolution W-4854, on December 2, 2010 the San Jose Water Company, California Water Service Company, California American Water, and Golden State Water Company were authorized to establish memorandum accounts to track the costs associated with the research, development and demonstration of pressure reducing valve modernization projects. The resolution: 1) authorized the water utilities to commence implementation of a Research, Development, and Demonstration (RD&D) program to test use of regenerative flow control valves (FCVs); 2) expedited Commission consideration and approval so projects and ratepayers benefit from federal tax credits; 3) approved the establishment of a separate memorandum account for each water utility to track the costs associated with the proposed RD&D projects; and 4) directed the water utilities, and encouraged electrical utilities, to work with the Division of Water and Audits (DWA) to finalize project details, select an engineering and design firm, and develop appropriate measurement, verification and evaluation protocols.

In Advice Letter 876-A, the Commission authorized California American Water to establish a new memorandum account which resulted in the following authorization in the Preliminary Statement:

*Pressure-Reducing Valve Modernization and Energy Recovery
Memorandum Account ("PRVMA")*

1. PURPOSE: *The purpose of the Pressure-Reducing Valve Modernization and Energy Recovery Memorandum Account ("PRVMA") is to track all of the costs associated with the Research, Development and Demonstration of electrical regenerative flow control valve project.*
2. APPLICABILITY: *The Los Angeles, Monterey and Coronado Districts.*
3. ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE: *California American Water shall track all PRVMA related costs paid by California American Water including, but not limited to, the cost of engineering and design, equipment, installation, outside contractors, software, administrative support, legal consulting and evaluation, measurement, and verification (EM&V).*
 - a. *A debit entry will be created each month to record costs.*
 - b. *Interest shall accrue to the PRVMA on a monthly basis by applying a rate equal to one-twelfth of the 3-month Commercial Paper Rate, as reported by the Federal Reserve Statistical Release.*
4. RATE RECOVERY: *California American Water may seek rate recovery of the PRVMA in its next general rate case or through a Tier 3 advice letter filing.*
5. EFFECTIVE DATE: *The PRVMA is effective as of December 7, 2010.*

As described below, Ordering Paragraph 3 of Resolution W-4854 directed California American Water and the other water and energy utilities to coordinate with the Department of Water and Audits, among other things, in the selection of project sites and project scope. In the Resolution, the Commission ordered the water utilities to track appropriate costs into the new PRVMA.

Request:

This advice letter is being filed pursuant to Ordering paragraphs 3 and 4 of Resolution W-4854, which states:

3. Water Utilities shall, and energy utilities should, work with the Division of Water and Audits (DWA) Staff to finalize project site details, develop project scope and select a single engineering and design firm. Water Utilities shall provide the funds

for the selected firm to work under the collaborative oversight of the DWA Staff, and these costs shall be entered into the new PRVMA.

4. Water Utilities shall, and energy utilities should, work with DWA Staff to develop evaluation, measurement and verification (EM&V) protocol and select an EM&V consultant. The consultant shall work under the collaborative oversight of DWA Staff. Water Utilities shall provide the funds for the consultant, and the costs shall be entered into the new PRVMA.

Resolution W-4854 was predicated by Advice Letter 853 which identified a potential project at the Beyer Blvd Station for the replacement of Pressure Regulating Valves (PRV) with Zeropex's Hydro Turbine Generator (HTG) along with an emergency bypass line for excess flow or when the HTG is being maintained.

California American Water and the retained consultant, Black and Veatch, have determined that the Beyer Blvd project site identified in Advice Letter 853 is not the preferred project and therefore wish to clarify the memorandum account to include the preferred project which is located at the Highland Tank site.

After original consideration of the Beyer Blvd PRV as the preferred project site, additional preliminary project data and pressure recordings were investigated resulting in the determination that the preferred project is the Highland Tank PRV site. SCADA data revealed that operation of the Highland Tank PRV occurs between 8 and 12 hours per day. Field data revealed that substantially higher pressure differential existed at the Highland Tank PRV compared to the Beyer Blvd PRV resulting in higher energy recovery potential. Additionally, flow through the Highland Tank PRV is greater than through the Beyer PRV, adding to the recovery potential. Generation potential at Highland Tank PRV far exceeds Beyer Blvd PRV by more than 4 times. The location of the Beyer PRV presented issues as it was partially within a parkway and would require additional space requirements to be constructed. This included the need to extend construction into the adjoining property for excavation and installation of the Difgen equipment. Since the Highland Tank PRV is located on California American Water property, construction will be much simpler. Additionally, if future expansion of the HTG was recommended it would have fewer site constraints at the Highland Tank PRV site. The above grade design at Highland Tank PRV mitigates the chance for flooding, especially as compared to the flooding potential at Beyer Blvd site.

RD&D Project Description:

The Highland Tank PRV is located at 2755 Palm Avenue in City of San Diego at the Highland Tank site. The Highland Tank PRV project includes the installation of Zeropex's Difgen flow control and pressure management system. The 16 inch PRV is located on the intake line to the Highland tank and serves to reduce system pressure by approximately 85 psi. From the estimate provided by Zeropex the HTG could produce on average 60.58 KW or more than four times the energy production of the original Beyer Blvd PRV site.

Cost Estimate:

The current cost estimate provided by Black and Veatch, the engineering design consultant, is shown below. Prior estimates included in Advice Letter 853 for the Beyer Blvd project were incomplete as they did not include consultant engineering costs, EM&V costs, and legal costs as authorized in Paragraphs 3 and 4 shown above.

- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material errors or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.


