**Purpose:**

The purpose of this advice letter filing is to implement General Rate Case Interim Rates, Cost of Capital Interim Rates, to establish a General Rate Case Interim Rate Memorandum Account for the Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts in General Rate Case (GRC) Application (A.) 10-07-007, and to establish a Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memorandum Account for the Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts in the Cost of Capital Application (A.) 11-05-003. These requests are in compliance with authorizations of the California Public Utilities Commission as detailed in the Rate Case Plan in D. 07-05-062.

**Background:**

California American Water filed its General Rate Case application (A. 10-07-007) on July 1, 2010 in which one request was to increase rates in its Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts for 2012.

California American Water filed its Cost of Capital application (A. 11-05-003) on May 2, 2011 to request an increase related to financing costs of California American Water. The request affects the rates for all operating properties of California American Water, including the Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts for 2012.

Submission of these tariffs is made in compliance with Paragraph 1 of Page 11 of the Rate Case Plan Decision (D.) 07-05-062 which states:

*"We conclude that companies experiencing a delay in their GRCs under our new RCP may seek a rate modification, subject to refund as set forth below, via and advice letter.<sup>6</sup> Our adopted procedure is set forth at II(B)*

*of the RCP. Section II(B) also sets forth the procedure for seeking permission to forego a GRC filing. We will not limit the rate changes sought in these filings to the rate of inflation. However, interim rates under Section 455.2(c), when approved, will be subject to refund and shall be adjusted upward or downward back to the effective date of the interim rates upon the adoption of final rates by the Commission at the conclusion of a GRC scheduled under the RCP. This procedure will only apply during our transition to the new RCP when the new RCP plan delays a water utility's GRC beyond the three-year cycle set forth in Section 455.2(c). We decline to adopt CWA's suggestion to permit utilities to file applications. Applications will unduly complicate the RCP schedule and create numerous inefficiencies. Furthermore, the advice letter process addresses all of CWA's concerns."*

And in compliance with Appendix A, Section II. B. of the Rate Case Plan (page A-2):

*"A water utility that experiences a delay beyond three-years in filing a GRC application due to the transition to the RCP schedule may seek to implement an interim rate change via an advice letter.*

*Such filing will not excuse a utility from filing its future GRCs according to the RCP schedule. These interim rates, when approved, will be subject to refund and shall be adjusted upward or downward back to the effective date of the interim rates with the adoption of final rates by the Commission at the conclusion of a GRC scheduled under the RCP.*

*The procedures herein will only apply during our transition to the RCP in instances when the RCP schedule delays a GRC for any water utility beyond the three-year cycle set forth in Section 455.2."*

To garner authority to implement interim rates and the corollary memorandum account the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") in the subject proceeding must issue a Ruling approving such a request. In compliance with the Ruling requirement and in regards to A.10-07-007, the ALJ in that proceeding issued a Ruling on October 25, 2011 where on Page 5 of Ruling Granting Interim Rates it states:

***"IT IS RULED*** *that California-American Water Company shall file with the Commission, by Tier 1 Advice Letter, a tariff implementing interim rates for all districts of its service territory and establishing a Memorandum Account to track the difference between the interim rates and the final rates adopted by the Commission in this proceeding. The interim rates shall become effective no sooner than January 1, 2012."*

In compliance with the Ruling requirement and in regards to A.11-05-001 (et.al.), the ALJ in that proceeding issued a Ruling on December 14, 2011 where starting on Page 3 of Ruling Granting Motion for Interim Rates it states:

***"IT IS RULED that:***

- 1. The motions of California-American Water Company and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates for Interim Relief are granted.*
- 2. Each applicant shall file a Tier 1 advice letter to establish a memorandum account to track, beginning January 1, 2012, the difference between the then authorized rates based on the most recent cost of capital authorized for such applicant and the final rates reflecting the new cost of capital adopted in this proceeding."*

The current Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) as of October 2011 provided by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics is 3.50%. California American Water anticipates that a rate increase will ultimately be approved for the Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts. Pursuant to D. 07-05-062, the 12-month CPI-U of 3.50%, is used to calculate the interim rates recommended effective January 1, 2012.

To avoid duplicate increases, the interim rates prepared and presented in this advice letter reflect an increase of 3.5% for the GRC Interim Rates and a 0.0% increase for the COC Interim Rates.

**Request:**

California American Water is requesting authorization to establish interim rates in the Coronado (San Diego County), Larkfield, Los Angeles (Los Angeles County), Sacramento, and Village (Ventura County) Districts by filing tariffs that increase present rates by 3.50% as set by the CPI Factor in accordance with California American Water's General Rate Case Filing (A.) 10-07-007 and in accordance with California American Water's Cost of Capital application (A.) 11-05-003. The difference in the Interim Rates and the final adopted rates from A. 10-07-007 would be tracked in the General Rate Case Interim Rate Memorandum Account and an Advice Letter would then be filed requesting a surcharge or surcredit of any under or over collection.

The difference between the final adopted rates in (A.)10-07-007 and the rates that should have been adopted had a decision in (A.) 10-07-007 incorporated the cost of capital from a decision in (A.) 11-05-003, would be tracked in the Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memorandum Account and an Advice Letter would then be filed requesting a surcharge or surcredit of any under or over collection.

**Tier Designation:**

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 filing.

**Effective Date:**

California American Water requests that the tariffs discussed above be made effective January 1, 2012.

**Service List:**

In accordance with Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being sent to those entities listed in Exhibit A.

**Protest and Responses:**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter.

A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material errors or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
