ABOUT THE CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER REBATE PROGRAM

California American Water customers residing in the Sacramento/Placer, San Diego, and Sonoma County service areas can still receive rebates directly from California American Water as described below. All rebate applications will be processed through the Sacramento's Conservation Department at 4701 Beloit Drive, Sacramento CA 95838. **For further information and questions please call (916) 568- 4201.**

California American Water's Rebate Incentive Program offers rebates for residential, commercial, industrial and/or institutional (or public authority) customers. Actual rebates may vary by district and may be less than the maximum rebate amounts listed below.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER IS NO LONGER PROVIDING REBATES FOR INSTALLING 1.6GPF TOILETS (ULFTS). You MUST install a high efficiency toilet (HET) using 1.28gpf or less to qualify for a rebate.

* Sacramento service area customers can receive the clothes washer rebate directly from the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) for both the water and energy HECW rebate incentive.

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More about California American Water's Rebate Incentive Program

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Device purchase(s) must occur within the program period of June 1, 2008 to December 31, 2009. The number of rebates and the dollar amount is dependent upon the availability of program funds.
2. The location of installation must be served by California American Water's Sacramento/Placer, San Diego, or Sonoma County service area systems.
3. Residential (single and multi-family), commercial, industrial and institutional (or public authority) applicants are eligible.
4. New construction is not eligible for a rebate under this program.
5. ONLY customers in the Sacramento county service areas qualify for the Landscape Irrigation Incentives.
6. Water account must be up to date on bill payments. Waivers can only be provided upon approval by the local Operations or General Manager for the applicable service area.
7. Must install an approved make and model HET, HECW, urinal, pre-rinse spray valve, waterbroom, rotor, rain sensor, WBIC, and artificial turf and/or hardscape for turf removal rebates. List of approved make and models are available from California American Water's Conservation Department (see below).

PROCEDURES FOR PARTICIPATING

1. First, call California American Water at 916-568-4201 to receive a list of eligible models and a rebate application or download at <http://www.amwater.com/caaw/customer-service/wise-water-use/index.html>.
2. Purchase and install the new approved device(s).
3. Return the original dated receipt(s) and installer's/plumber's invoice(s) with the cost, model and brand of each device listed individually, copy of your water bill and the completed application. Keep a copy for your records.
4. Submitting a signed application represents an agreement to have California American Water verify installation of the device(s) including an onsite inspection with your accompaniment. Submission of before-and-after photographs of the appliance(s) and/or device(s) retrofitted may be accepted as a waiver to inspection.
5. Customer rebates may vary from service area and are subject to change. Call us to verify the amount you are eligible for. Rebate amount will not exceed money spent. Eligible expenses include devices listed under rebate incentives such as clothes washers, waterbrooms, urinals, MP regular and large rotors, rain sensors, Smart or weather-based irrigation controllers (WBICs), flush tanks, toilet valves, and toilet related items (seat, supply line, wax ring, caulking, bolts and covers), pre-rinse spray valves, as well as tax and cost of professional installation.
6. California American Water will issue rebate check(s) within six to eight weeks of receipt of your completed application.
7. California American Water or their representative is required to send IRS Form 1099 to the customer and the IRS when rebates total \$600 or more.
