

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT SESSIONS IN BULLHEAD CITY AND LAKE HAVASU CITY ON THE APPLICATION OF ARIZONA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY FOR RATE INCREASES FOR UTILITY SERVICE IN MULTIPLE DISTRICTS.
(DOCKET NOS. W-01303A-08-0227 AND SW-01303A-08-0227)**

On May 2, 2008, as revised on June 20, 2008, Arizona-American Water Company, Inc. (“Company”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for permanent revenue increases for its following Districts: Agua Fria Water District, Havasu Water District, Mohave Water District, Paradise Valley Water District, Sun City West Water District, Tubac Water District, and Mohave Wastewater District.

Commission Sets Local Public Comment Sessions

The Commission has recently set two local public comment sessions, to be held in Bullhead City and Lake Havasu City. Details of the currently scheduled public comment sessions appear below.
