2. Any residential Customer who has installed a Residential Fire Sprinkler System (RFSS) as part of their regular domestic service at their place of residence will be eligible to request to have their monthly service adjusted to reflect the increased service size necessary for operation of the RFSS. To be eligible for the monthly service charge reduction, the customer must request the adjustment and the Company must then verify that the lower size of meter would be large enough to provide adequate service to the residence. If eligible, customers who have a 1" or 3/4" meter in lieu of a 5/8" meter, will be billed a monthly service charge equal to that of the 5/8" meter. If eligible, any other residential customer with an RFSS and a meter size greater than 1" will have their monthly service charge reduced by one meter size. The RFSS is not considered a fire service by the Company, but is considered an oversized general metered service and therefore, only the rules and conditions of service for general metered service apply.
3. Per the final decision of A. 07-01-037, a surcharge of \$0.0720 per ccf will be applied to each bill to fund conservation efforts. The surcharge will be applied beginning the effective date of the final decision and will remain in effect until otherwise directed by the Commission.
4. A surcharge is included in each bill to collect the difference in revenues between the Interim rates approved in AL 684 and final authorized rates in D. 08-05-018. The monthly meter surcharge will be added to all meter sizes for all customer classes for the remaining 4 months of 2008 or for 4 months beginning the effective date of Advice Letter 699. - (1) The organization operating the facility must provide a copy of the 501(c) (3) document certifying tax-exempt status.
- (2) All California American Water accounts must be in the name of the organization holding the tax-exempt status.
- (3) All of the residents or clients (including family units) occupying the facility at any given time must individually meet current income eligibility requirements as shown in Section 1 of this tariff schedule.

b. Facilities that are not eligible for the program:

- 1. Nonprofit facilities providing social services only.
- 2. Group living facilities providing no other service than a place to live.
- 3. Government owned or operated facilities.
- 4. Government-subsidized facilities providing lodging only.

c. Additional requirements;

Group living facilities must provide special-needs social services such as meals or rehabilitation, and may have satellite facilities in the name of one licensed organization that meet The same requirements as the main facility.
