Dear Pine Hill Resident:

Beginning the week of January 26, New Jersey American Water will be installing approximately 2,100 feet of water main in Branch Road from Blackwood/Clementon Road to Cross. This project will improve the reliability of water service to the area. Once completed, the pipeline will interconnect New Jersey American Water with Pine Hill Municipal Utilities Authority to provide Pine Hill MUA with an alternative water source for the future.

For the safety of the public, our employees and our authorized contractors, alternating traffic control will be necessary on Branch Road under the direction of the Pine Hill Police Department. All local traffic including residents, school busses, mail carriers and trash vehicles will be provided access to minimize inconvenience.

Be assured that our crews will work quickly and diligently to complete this important improvement to our distribution system. Should you require access to your property during the hours of construction, please notify one of the traffic control officers stationed at both ends of the construction site, and use extra caution and obey all traffic signs.

Weather permitting, installation of the pipeline should be completed by February 13. Roadway restoration work will follow in the spring of this year.
