**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 2, 2008, Arizona-American Water Company ("Arizona-American" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a rate increase and on June 20, 2008, filed the above-captioned Revised Application.

5 The hearing in this matter began on March 19, 2009, at the Commission's Phoenix offices.

6 The Commission has scheduled a number of public comment hearings in the service areas  
7 affected by the application.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **public comment session** shall be held in **Bullhead**  
9 **City, Arizona** on Thursday, **April 30, 2009, commencing at 6:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as  
10 practicable, in the **Mohave High School Auditorium, located at 2251 Highway 95, Bullhead City,**  
11 **Arizona, 86442** in order to allow customers of Arizona American Water Company to provide public  
12 comment for the record in this case.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **public comment session** shall be held in **Lake Havasu**  
14 **City, Arizona** on Friday, **May 1, 2009, commencing at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as  
15 practicable, in the **Community Recreation/Aquatic Center Facility, located at 100 Park Avenue,**  
16 **Lake Havasu City, Arizona 86403** in order to allow customers of Arizona American Water  
17 Company to provide public comment for the record in this case.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall provide public notice of the public  
19 comment sessions on this matter, in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 24  
20 point bold type and the body in no less than 10 point regular type:

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona-American Water Company shall file certification  
2 of publication as soon as practicable after the publication has been completed.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon publication of same,  
4 notwithstanding the failure of an individual customer to read or receive the notice.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
6 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.


7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
8 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
9 *hac vice*.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
11 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
12 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances  
13 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is  
14 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
15 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
17 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
18 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
20 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
