This advice letter filing is being made in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 9 of D. 09-07-022 issued on July 9, 2009 under General Rate Case Application (A.) 08-01-023, which states;

The California American Water Company is authorized to file in accordance with General Order 96, and to make effective on not less than five days' notice, the revised tariff schedules for the Monterey Wastewater District that are attached as Appendix C to this order. The revised tariff schedules shall apply to service rendered on and after their effective date.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Effective Date:

Cal-Am submits this advice letter under a Tier 1 designation and requests the rates to become effective on July 14, 2009.

Copies of the detailed workpapers and the documents supporting this Advice Letter have been furnished to the Commission Staff.

In accordance with Section 4.3 of General Order 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being furnished to those entities listed in Exhibit A.

Protests and Responses:

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter.

A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
