We also provide water service to 30 additional communities through bulk purchase water agreements. More than 860 highly-skilled professionals including water quality specialists, distribution and field service personnel, plant operators, meter readers, and engineers, carry out the company's foremost priority of providing safe, reliable water and wastewater service to our customers.

## **INVESTED IN OUR FACILITIES**

Our team of experts regularly monitors, maintains and upgrades our facilities to continue to operate efficiently and meet regulatory standards. This requires investing millions each year in our infrastructure, including treatment plants, tanks, pump stations, pipes, fire hydrants and metering equipment. We do this because we care about our customers as much as we care about water. Statewide, we invested more than \$507 million in 2023 to improve the water treatment and pipeline systems.

## **HIGH-QUALITY WATER SERVICE**

We have an exceptional track record of meeting or surpassing water quality standards. Each year, our team of experts performs thousands of tests statewide on the water before it leaves our treatment plants and in the pipes we use to deliver your water service, monitoring for more than 90 contaminants. Plus, we have access to American Water's Central Laboratory in Belleville, Illinois, which conducts sophisticated drinking water testing and analysis.

We've earned five Directors Awards from the U.S. EPA's Partnership for Safe Water program for our long-term commitment to optimizing operations and achieving outstanding performance.



# **COMMUNITY PARTNER**

Here are just a few ways we take an active part in our communities:

- American Water Charitable Foundation Water and Environment Grants: Grants focus on clean water, conservation, environmental education, climate variability, and water-based recreation.
- **Speakers' Bureau:** We provide presentations on water-related topics.
- **Volunteer Firefighting Support Grants:** Provides grants of up to \$2,500 to assist volunteer emergency service organizations.
