PURPOSE

The purpose of this advice letter is update the refund allocation filed in Advice Letter 1246 which complied with Ordering Paragraph 20 of Decision D.18-12-021, which states that California American Water shall refund customers the excess unprotected (non-plant) Accumulated Deferred Income Tax (ADIT) of \$7.1 million, grossed up to \$9.9 million, as a bill credit, based on the size of a customer's meter.

BACKGROUND

In D.18-12-021 Ordering Paragraph 20, the Commission ordered California American Water to return the original estimated non-plant excess of \$7.1 million by filing a tier 2 advice letter on June 30, 2019. Specifically, Ordering Paragraph 20, D.18-12-021, p.325, states:

20. By June 30, 2019, California American Water Company (Cal-Am) shall file a Tier 2 advice letter with Water Division to refund the \$7.1 million of Excess Unprotected Accumulated Deferred Income Tax as a bill credit, based on the size of the customer's meter. Cal-Am shall amortize the refund equally over the 24-month period from 2019 to 2020.

California American Water grossed up the \$7.1 million amount to \$9.9 million.1

On July 1, 2019, California American Water filed Advice Letter 1246, which was approved by the Commission on August 5, 2019. Through the implementation of the refund of the non-plant related excess ADIT, California American Water determined that Private Fire Service customers were receiving disproportionately high meter based refunds compared to water customer refunds. As proposed in Advice Letter 1246, Private Fire Service customers would receive the same meter based bill credit as water customers, but Private Fire customers meter rates are less than those of water service customers. Therefore, in this filing California American Water reallocated the grossed up \$9.9 million, by creating a separately calculated bill credit for private fire customers by District, which in turn adjusted the refund amounts for water customers.

Ordering paragraph 20 states that California American Water return the balance over 24 months. For this Tier 2 advice letter, California American Water assumes rates become effective October 17, 2019.

REQUEST

This advice letter requests, authorization to adjust the refund to customers for the excess non-plant ADIT, grossed up to \$9.9 million, as a bill credit, based on the size of a customer's meter.

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
