American Water has long believed in the importance of being a good neighbor and good steward of the environment. The primary focus of the American Water Charitable Foundation is to support employees in their own charitable endeavors, provide stronger support for disaster relief efforts, and to provide funding for higher-level initiatives related to clean water, conservation, education, and community sustainability. Since inception, the Foundation has provided more than \$7.2 million in funding through grants and matching gifts. Here are a few highlights from 2020.

GIVING BACK: \$1.7 MILLION

We donated \$1.7 million to support programs and organizations important to our employees and our communities.

FOCUS ON OUR EMPLOYEES



Employee Volunteer and Matching Gift Program

\$348,000 donated as a match to causes important to employees. In addition, employees contributed \$500,000 toward corporate giving campaigns* and other organizations through the matching gift program.

American Water Employee Crisis Fund

\$100,000 was donated to support employees experiencing unexpected financial hardship due to an unforeseen situation, such as a natural disaster or family emergency.



Together with match, over 2,600 employees donated \$848,000 to 1,300 public charities.

FOCUS ON OUR COMMUNITIES



COVID-19 Relief Fund

\$355,000 awarded to 85 organizations nationwide to support coronavirus relief efforts.



Keep Communities Flowing Grants

\$153,000 awarded to 12 organizations focused on water and environment, water and healthy living, environmental education and community sustainability.



Signature Grant Program Building Better Communities

\$500,000 awarded to two communities to construct all-inclusive recirculated splash pads in Franklin, IN, and Lawson, MO.



United Way and Water For People

\$100,000 awarded to support American Water's two corporate giving campaigns, *Employees donated \$157,000 to Water For People and \$148,000 to United Way.



Camden Community Grant Program

\$50,000 awarded to support two Camden-based organizations, home of American Water's corporate headquarters.
