WASTEWATER SYSTEM ACQUISITION

The **WISWGI** is located in **WISWGI** existing Illinois American Water Alton District service area of more than 18,000 customers. The **WISWGI** provides **WISWGI** wastewater service to approximately **WISWGI** customers.

CHALLENGES

SOLUTION

BENEFITS
