



HELPING CUSTOMERS IN NEED

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act passed by Congress on March 27th, 2020 provides more than \$2 trillion in economic relief to families affected by the COVID-19 public health emergency. These relief funds have also made it possible for Michigan American Water to provide relief to customers in the form of a water arrearage payments of up to \$700 through the SB690 – Water Assistance Program.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- If you missed a payment from March 1 to August 30, 2020 and are receiving food assistance through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), you are eligible for assistance through the COVID Water Payment Program.
- You do not need to apply or do anything to participate in this program. The
 Michigan Department of Health & Human Services will determine eligibility
 and send payments to Michigan American Water. The financial assistance
 will be administered through your local Community Action Agency and will
 cover your missed payments of up to \$700.
- The payment made by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services toward your water arrearage will appear on your billing statement.
