DEWATERING

PART 1: GENERAL

1.01 GENERAL

- A. Should water be encountered, furnish and operate pumping equipment of sufficient capacity to dewater the excavation. Dewater the excavation so that the laying and joining of the pipe or setting of equipment is made in a dry environment so as to prevent water from entering the pipe during construction or causing other construction issues.
- B. No additional sum will be allowed for any reasonably anticipated dewatering operation, overtime, equipment rental or any other expense incurred due to the occurrence of ground water, surface water or water from possible leakage of existing buildings, structures and piping in the vicinity of the Contractor's operations. If Contractor believes unreasonable, unanticipated wet conditions exist, immediately contact Owner to decide appropriate measures and to determine whether Contractor is entitled to additional compensation.
- C. Convey all excavation water to a natural drainage channel or storm sewer without causing any property damage. Discharge shall be in strict accordance with all federal, state and/or local requirements.
- D. Dispose of silt and debris which accumulates during construction in strict accordance with all federal, state, and local requirements.

1.02 PERMITS

The Contractor shall obtain and pay for any permits required for dewatering and disposal.
