Community involvement and charitable giving is at the heart of New Jersey American Water and our employees. We encourage employee volunteerism and donate thousands of dollars to charitable organizations throughout our service areas each year. We believe by working together with partners, sponsoring charity events, supporting organizations through grants and participating in community activities, New Jersey American Water and its committed workforce can help build better, stronger communities. Here are a few highlights.

## **EMPLOYEES ENGAGED IN OUR COMMUNITIES**

42 of our employees contributed a combined \$26,000 to United Way. In addition, New Jersey American Water contributed \$15,000.

Our employees donated **2,000 lbs. of food and raised \$7,000** to support food banks in the communities we serve.



# **GIVING BACK: MORE THAN \$1.5 MILLION**

We donated \$1,287,000 to organizations in our communities through grants, general charitable contributions, and programming support and \$245,000 to assist customers in paying their water or wastewater bill.



**COVID-19 Relief Efforts:** \$100,000 across the state, focusing specifically on supporting health care systems, food banks and meal programs that operate in the communities we serve.

Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Credit Grants to Two Organizations \$950,000 (combined)





## H2O Help to Others Customer Assistance Grants

For nearly two decades, New Jersey American Water has been assisting low-income customers facing circumstances that stretch their financial resources.

In 2020, 342 grants were provided to households in need.





### **American Water Charitable Foundation**

- **\$14,970** awarded to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Union County through the Foundation's "Keep Communities Flowing" grant program.
- **\$25,000** donated to the NJ Pandemic Relief Fund to support COVID-19 relief efforts in New Jersey.
- **\$125,360** donated to 174 non-profit organizations in New Jersey, inclusive of employee donations and the volunteer/matching gift program. This includes employee contributions to United Way.
- \$50,000 awarded to two non-profit organizations in New Jersey through the Camden Community Grant program.
