## Simple Steps to Save Water

Let your host know if there are any leaking faucets. One drop every 2 seconds from a leaky faucet wastes 2 gallons of water every day. That's water - and money - down the drain.


Don't let faucets run when brushing, shaving, or washing the dishes. Just turning off the water while you brush can save 200 gallons a month.

Run washing machines only when they are full, or select the properly-sized wash cycle for the current laundry load.

Take shorter showers. Bathrooms account for the largest water consumption percentage inside homes. Showers alone use five gallons of water per minute.
