Pennsylvania American Water has been providing high quality, reliable water service to Lower Alsace and surrounding communities for more than 21 years, and wastewater service to the Exeter community since the fall of 2019. Today, our Glen Alsace and Exeter districts serve over 17,000 Berks County homes and businesses.

INVESTED IN YOUR COMMUNITY

In 2022, we invested \$485 million to upgrade our water and wastewater systems across the Commonwealth. Over the past five years, we've funded more than \$2 billion in capital construction, and we expect to invest \$450 to \$600 million annually statewide over the next several years. In our Glen Alsace and Exeter districts, we have invested just under \$3 million over the last five years to replace aging water mains. We've also made upgrades to our water treatment plants, tanks and pump stations, bringing our total combined investment in these two systems to over \$27 million.

ECONOMIC IMPACT OF WATER INVESTMENTS

Economic impact studies show that for every \$1 million invested in water infrastructure, upwards of 15 jobs are generated throughout the economy. Pennsylvania American Water invested approximately \$490 million in 2022 alone to improve our water and wastewater treatment and pipeline systems, supporting more than 7,000 jobs.
