- For the fourth year in a row, West Virginia American Water employees, family and friends partnered with the CAMC Foundation to host the Terri's Tribute Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign. In 2025 alone, the Terri's Tribute Campaign raised more than \$39,000 for the Vandalia Health Breast Center. In addition, \$4,000 was contributed through the AWCF Matching Gift Program, bringing the total raised to more than \$43,000 to support breast cancer patients.
