

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
MONITORING REQUIREMENTS NOT MET FOR**

WVAWC-KANAWHA VALLEY DIST, WV3302016

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 1/1/2022 and 6/30/2022, we failed to submit the required samples as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

Lead and copper monitoring was required of this system at 100 locations. Per state regulations, all sites must be approved by our regulators prior to collection. A sample plan was submitted to regulators prior to collection; however, there was a delay in approval of the final site by their office. In order to meet the sampling deadline, the final site was collected prior to regulatory approval. All required samples were collected and analyzed. The results of sampling showed the water met the requirements of the Lead and Copper Rule. No further action is required at this time.
