ADVICE LETTER NO. 1322

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California-American Water Company (U210W) hereby submits for review this advice letter, including the following attached tariff sheets applicable to its California Districts:

Purpose:

The purpose of this filing is to comply with ordering Paragraph 41 of Decision (D.) 18-12-021, which requires an accounting of conservation collections and expenditures for 2018, 2019 and 2020 and a proposal for flowing back to customers any over collected conservation balances for the period of 2018 through 2020.

Background:

On November 23, 2020 California American Water filed AL 1316 which was approved by the Commission December 29, 2020. AL 1316 referenced D.18-12-021 which was issued on December 21, 2018 nearly one year after the scheduled rate implementation date of January 1, 2018. Ordering Paragraph 41 of D. 18-12-021 provides

California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) is authorized to shift authorized conservation budget amounts between best management practice rate categories within a service area. Cal-Am shall continue to track conservation expenses in the one-way California American Water Conservation Surcharge Balancing Accounts with any unspent funds refunded to ratepayers on an annual basis after the end of each year of the General Rate Case cycle. Cal-Am shall file a Tier 2 advice letter no later than 45 days after the end of each year providing an accounting of conservation funds spent with supporting documentation, as well as a proposal to refund to customers any unspent budgeted funds.

AL 1316 also noted that California American Water filed advice letter 1225 on February 16, 2019 in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 41.

AL 1316 also noted California American Water will make its final compliance filing by February 16, 2021, no later than 45 days after the end of the year and will provide a final accounting and make any applicable refunds for the period covering 2018 through 2020. Through this filing California American Water submits its final compliance filing per D.18-12-021.

Request:

In compliance with Ordering Paraph 41 of D.18-12-021, California American Water requests that over-collected conservation balances be returned to customers through a meter-based refund

over a twelve-month period. The one exception would be for customers in the Central Division¹ where the over-collected conservation balances would be netted against the existing Consolidated Expense Balancing Account ("CEBA") balances. This action will shorten the recovery period for the CEBA balances in the Central Division and reduce the overall impact of surcharges.

Tier Designation:

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

Effective Date:

As to the only filing regarding compliance with Ordering Paraph 41 of D.18-12-021, California American Water does not request a specific effective date because this is a compliance filing that does not require any changes to California American tariffs.

Service List:

In accordance with Section 4.3 of General Order 96-B, a copy of this advice letter has been served upon all interested and affected parties as shown in Exhibit A.

Protests and Responses:

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter.

A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies:
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material errors or omissions:
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

¹ The Central Division includes both the Monterey and the Central Satellite Service Areas.
