ADVICE LETTER NO. 1384

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California-American Water Company (California American Water) (U210W) hereby submits for review this advice letter, including the following tariff sheets applicable to its Private Fire Protection Service in all Districts.

Purpose:

The purpose of this advice letter filing is to request recovery of the 2019 General Rate Case ("GRC") Interim Rate Memorandum Account for the Private Fire Protection Service in all districts in connection with California American Water's 2019 General Rate Case in A.19-07-004. This request is in compliance with authorizations of the California Public Utilities Commission as detailed in the Rate Case Plan in D. 07-05-062 ("RCP") and the Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Granting Interim Rates ("Ruling") issued on September 10, 2020 in A.19-07-004.

Background:

D.21-11-018 was issued on November 23, 2021, nearly one year after 2021 test year rates were scheduled to be in effect. Given the delay in the final decision, California was granted authorization to track in a memorandum account the difference between interim rates and final rates for subsequent recovery or refund. Consistent with the Ruling, California American Water filed Advice Letter 1318-A which implemented interim rates effective January 1, 2021 and established the GRC Interim Rate True-up Memorandum Account to track the differences between revenues billed at interim rates and revenues that should have been billed under the final rates implemented and billed under D.21-11-018.

Consistent with D.21-11-018 California American Water filed its GRC implementation advice letter, Advice Letter 1353, on December 23, 2021. California American Water then filed for 2022 Escalation Year Rates (Advice Letter 1356) and its 2022 Annual Consumption Adjustment Mechanism ("ACAM") (Advice Letter 1359), also consistent with D.21-11-018. All rates and tariffs associated were implemented and began billing on March 4, 2022.

In order to calculate the interim rate true-up, California American Water needed new rates to bill for multiple billing cycles. California American Water hereby submits this filing to recover the balances in the GRC Interim Rate True-up Memorandum Account for its Private Fire Protection Service in all Districts.

Request:

California American Water requests the following interim rate true-up surcharge and surcredits: (1) a flat rate surcharge in the Northern Division for the undercollected amount of

\$83,369; (2) a surcredit in the Southern Division for the overcollected amount of \$147,091; and (3) a surcredit in the Central Division for the overcollected amount of \$67,534. The surcharge and surcredit will be collected and refunded, respectively, through the end of 2023 covering the remaining General Rate Case period.

Additionally, this advice letter will include clean-up to fire service tariff sheet number 7 to add the Sacramento and Meadowbrook 2020 Excess Plant Related Accumulated Deferred Income Tax and the Franchise Fee language, both of which were inadvertently removed in a previous filing. These changes do not impact authorized rates and all customers were billed correctly with respect to the modifications addressed above.

- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.
