ADVICE LETTER NO. 1347

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, California-American Water Company (U210W) submits this advice letter, including tariff sheets applicable to California American Water's East Pasadena Service Area.

Background:

On April 6, 2020, California American Water filed ("A.") 20-04-003 requesting approval of the sale of East Pasadena Water Company's ("East Pasadena") assets to California American Water. On August 6, 2021, the Commission approved the asset sale and transfer of ownership in Decision ("D.") 21-08-002. California American Water closed the sale on September 21, 2021.

On August 13, 2021 and in accordance with Ordering Paragraph ("OP") 7 of D.21-08-002, California American Water submitted Advice Letter ("AL") 1344 (Tier 1) to establish the East Pasadena Transaction Memorandum Account ("EPTMA") and to expand California American Water's existing Memorandum Account for Environmental Improvement and Compliance Issues with Acquisitions to include East Pasadena.

Discussion:

The requests contained in this advice letter relate to OP 2 and OP 6 of D. 21-08-002, which state:

- 2. California-American Water Company's (Cal-Am's) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is modified to incorporate the East Pasadena Water System service area into Cal-Am's Los Angeles County District.
- 6. Existing rates for customers of the East Pasadena Water Company shall remain in effect until subsequently modified by this Commission.

Based on the foregoing OPs, California American Water submits the following requests to incorporate East Pasadena's rate schedules and service area maps into California American Water's tariffs.

Requests:

California American Water requests authority to integrate the East Pasadena service area and rates into its existing tariffs, rules, and maps. Included in this integration are East Pasadena's existing balancing accounts outlined in Preliminary Statement BL, BM, and BN.

In addition, California American Water requests to modify East Pasadena's tariff for General Metered Service in Schedule No. EP-1 to offer customers greater transparency and accuracy. California American Water requests to exclude Temp Surcharge 2 and its associated Special Condition #2 related to its Regulatory Balancing Account from the tariffs. Per East Pasadena Advice Letter 108, this surcharge expired in May 2021.

Furthermore, California American Water requests to exclude Temp Surcharge 3 and its associated Special Condition #3 related to the Conservation Lost Revenue Memorandum Account ("CLRMA") and the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act ("TCJA") Memorandum Account from the tariffs. Advice Letter 109 requested the addition of this surcharge in February 2020 but has yet to be approved by the Commission and is not expected to be approved prior to the integration close date of September 21, 2021. Upon approval of this surcharge California American Water will file a separate advice letter to implement the approved surcharge.

Finally, California American Water requests to isolate the Purchase Power and Pumping Assessment surcharge of \$0.0274/CCF (\$0.0037/CGL) currently combined into East Pasadena's quantity rates to offer customers greater transparency into their rates.

California American Water requests an effective date of September 21, 2021, the date of closing.

California American Water submits this as a Tier 1 advice letter pursuant to General Order No. 96-B.

Notice:

Protests and Responses:

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds¹ are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or

- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:



Stage 2 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan will be enacted upon a determination that water usage should be further reduced from current levels, that a temporary water emergency exists necessitating implementation or that the requirements of Stage 1 are ineffective in complying with the necessary reduction.
- 3. Stage 3 Second Enforcement Stage of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan A Stage 3 Water Shortage Contingency Plan condition exists when it is determined that due to drought/other water supply conditions, a water supply shortage or threatened shortage exists and a further consumer demand reduction is necessary to make more efficient use of water and appropriately respond to existing water conditions. Stage 3 of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan will be enacted upon a determination that waler usage should be further reduced from current levels, that a temporary water emergency exists necessitating implementation or that the requirements in Stage 1 & 2 are ineffective in complying with the necessary reduction.

- 4. Stage 4 Third Enforcement Stage of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan A Stage 4 Water Shortage Contingency Plan condition is also referred to as an "Emergency" Condition. A Stage 3 condition exists when it is determined that a critical water shortage emergency exists or that the measures in Stage 1 through 3 are ineffective in complying with a necessary reduction.
- 5. Stage 5 Mandatory Rationing. A rationing plan will be implemented when it is determined that the efforts in Stage 4 are insufficient to meet the regulatory or physical limitations of the available water supply.

D. MANDATORY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS AT EACH STAGE

- 1. In addition to the water use restrictions listed in utility's Rule 14.1-Section A (which become mandatory when a stage of Schedule 14.1 is activated), the following mandatory restrictions apply to water usage at each stage of mandatory rationing. These reduced usage levels shall be determined based on a per meter size allotment:
 - a. Stage 2: Customer usage reduced to 90% of base amount.
 3/4" and smaller = 24 ccf/month, 1 1/2" = 33 ccf/month, 2" = 168 ccf/month, 3" and larger = 500 ccf/month
 - Stage 3: Customer usage reduced to 80% of base amount.
 3/4" and smaller = 17 ccf/month, 1 1/2" = 23 ccf/month, 2" = 118 ccf/month, 3" and larger = 350 ccf/month
 - c. Stage 4: Customer usage reduced to 75% of base amount.
 3/4" and smaller = 13 ccf/month, 1 1/2" = 18 ccf/month, 2" = 90 ccf/month, 3" and larger = 267 ccf/month
 - d. Stage 5: Customer usage reduced to 90% of base amount.
 3/4" and smaller = 24 ccf/month, 1 1/2" = 33 ccf/month, 2" = 168 ccf/month, 3" and larger = 500 ccf/month

E. WATER USE VIOLATION FINE

1. When an Enforcement Stage of the Water Shortage Contingency Plan has been activated by Commission authorization, the water use restrictions of Stage 1 in the Water Shortage Contingency Plan in Section A of Rule 14.1 become subject to fines and penalties imposed by the utility. The utility will first work closely with local law enforcement and public agencies charged with enforcing the mandatory water use restrictions. However, should the utility find that the local agency is not effectively enforcing the mandatory use restrictions, the utility, after written warnings, such as door hangers and letters, may begin to issue fines. If a customer is seen violating the water use restrictions, as outlined in Rule 14.1 and the Special Conditions below, the customer will be subject to the following fine structure:
