PURPOSE:

In accordance with Section 7.3.1 of the Water Industry Rules under General Order (GO) 96-B and section 454 of the Public Utilities Code, California American Water is seeking authority to offset Purchased Water Expenses it incurs from the various water wholesalers that supply water to its Los Angeles District Service Areas. These various water wholesalers recently increased rates to California American Water. California American Water requests that the full increase be offset in base rates to account for annual change in purchased water cost.

BACKGROUND:

California American Water serves approximately 27,600 customers in the Los Angeles Area, which includes Baldwin Hills, Duarte, and San Marino.

The increase in water rates resulted in a \$2,251,397 annual increase in purchased water expense to California American Water, plus a corresponding increase of \$11,574 in

uncollectible for a total increase of \$2,262,971. This increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate. The resulting final purchased water surcharge by service area is as follows:

REQUEST:

California American Water is requesting authorization to increase the quantity rates on its Baldwin Hills Service Area Customer by \$0.0182 for a new total of \$0.0451, on its Duarte Service Area Customers by \$0.0062 for a new total of \$0.0990, and on its San Marino Service Area by \$0.0617 for a new total of \$.0909 in order to properly recover the increased purchased water expense it incurs from all of the various water wholesalers that supply water to California American Water's Los Angeles Districts Service Areas.

The offset requested represents an increase of \$2,262,971 or 5.78% over the latest revenue requirement provided and approved by the Commission in D. 15-04-007.

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- (2) The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

The total amount will be recovered from all classes of customers.
