Purpose:

This advice letter filing is being made to correct the name and rate for the City of Sand City Business License Fee. Additionally, the franchise taxes and/or business license fees listed in the Special Conditions were updated to be consistent across the Monterey County Tariff Area. This change applies to California American Water's Monterey County District Tariff Area.

Background:

It came to the attention of California American Water that both the name and rate for the Sand City Business License Fee should be updated on Monterey County District tariffs.

Request:

California American Water is requesting authorization to change the name and rate outlined in the Special Conditions, Fees and Surcharges on Monterey County District Tariff Schedules MO-1C, MO-1-MF, MO-1O, MO-1-SF to "City of Sand City Business License Fee 0.12%,".

Tier Designation:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 filing.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests that the tariffs discussed above, be made effective April 17, 2019.

- (4) The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

- 3. D.18-12-021 authorized a three-year conservation budget of \$2,298,500 for 2018-2020 for Monterey County. Per AL 1230 a surcharge of \$0.0751 per hundred gallons will be applied to each bill to fund California American Water conservation efforts.
- 4. Per Advice Letter 1230, a surcharge of \$1.81 for the Low-Income Ratepayer Assistance Program ("LIRAP") Balancing Account will be collected from all non-low income water and wastewater customers and will remain in effect until updated as part of Cal-AM's GRC for the 2018 test year.
- 5. Per Advice Letter 1152, a fee of 8.325%, imposed by the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD), will be assessed against the customer's monthly base bill to fund MPWMD'S environmental mitigation, water supply, and conservation programs, as well as other activities. The fee will remain in effect until otherwise directed by the Commission. This fee is applicable to customers in the Monterey Main, Bishop, Hidden Hills and Ryan Ranch areas.
- 6. In accordance with the final decision issued in Monterey General Rate Case Application 08-01-027, costs associated with securing Seaside Basin water rights shall be placed in a balancing account and collected through a meter charge over the next ten years. The total amount to be recovered is \$2,755,960. The Seaside Basin Adjudication Balancing Account and surcharge is applicable to customers in the Monterey main, Bishop, Hidden Hills and Ryan Ranch areas and will earn interest at the 90-day commercial rate.

- 1. Customers who use Cal-Am's system to provide for fire flow, but do not receive their domestic supply from Cal-Am, will pay a special Private Fire Service rate equal to either the higher of the standard rate for their size service or a rate equal to the sum of the standard monthly Service Charges that would be billed for all the properties served by the Private Fire Service if they did receive domestic service. All fire service to non-domestic customers will be considered private fire service. If a new public fire hydrant is required to be installed for a non-domestic customer and other customers will benefit, no fee will be charged.
- 2. A surcharge is included on each bill to collect franchise taxes and/or business license fees paid to various municipalities. The amount collected is based on a percentage of the gross revenues of each bill. The percentage are as follows: Ryan Ranch 1.00%, City of Pacific Grove 2.00%, City of Carmel-bythe-Sea 2.00%, City of Seaside 1.00%, City of Del Rey Oaks Business License Fee 0.11%, City of Del Rey Oaks Franchise Fee 2.00%, City of Sand City Business License Fee 0.12%, City of Monterey 1.00%, and unincorporated areas of Monterey County 1.00%.
- 3. Coastal Water Project (CWP) Surcharge #1: Per Decision 06-12-040, a surcharge will be applied to customer bills to collect for pre-construction costs associated with the CWP. Costs to be recovered through CWP Surcharge #1 include \$1,353,831 in public outreach costs and \$1,639,429 in other costs, for a total of \$2,993,260. A surcharge of 4% will be added to all bills rendered from January 1, 2007 through June 30, 2007. The surcharge will be increased to 7% from July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 and will increase to 10% from January 1, 2008 through September 29, 2011. On September 30, 2011, the surcharge will increase to 15% through a time when the outstanding approved amounts, with interest, are recovered. This surcharge is applicable to customers in the Monterey main system.
