Purpose:

California American Water requests authority pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Water Industry Rules, Section 7.3.1, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to offset purchased water expenses it incurs from the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District related to the Pure Water Monterey project.

In accordance with Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being sent to those entities listed in Exhibit 1.

Background:

Submission of these tariffs is made in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision (D.)16-09-021, issued September 22, 2016 which states:

1. California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) is authorized to enter into the Revised Water Purchase Agreement contained in Appendix C.

The Revised Water Purchase Agreement (RWPA) (Attachment A) provides that the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) shall provide California American Water with written notice of the Company Water Rate prior to the Performance Start Date of the Pure Water Monterey project. The approved RWPA then provides that upon receiving the written notice California American Water "shall file a Tier 1 advice letter for rate recovery with the CPUC to update its rates and tariffs, and in doing so establish a surcharge rate to reflect the Company Water Rate." As set forth in the RWPA, "[i]n the first year following the Performance Start Date, the Company Water Rate shall not exceed \$1,720 per acre foot (the 'Soft Cap')."²

Written notice of the Company Water Rate was provided to California American Water on April 29, 2020. In this notice, MPWMD and Monterey One Water (collectively "the public agencies") informed California American Water the Company Water Rate would be set at \$1,720 per AF. The public agencies have further informed California American Water that the Performance Start Date will be on or about August 10, 2020. California American Water therefore files this Tier 1 Advice Letter to establish the Company Water Rate at \$1,720 per AF in conformance with the Commission approved RWPA.

The public agencies also informed California American Water that year one water purchase costs will exceed the soft cap of \$1,720 per AF. In the April 29, 2020 notice, California American Water was advised the projected Company Water Rate had increased to \$2,442 for FY 2020-21, and \$2,639 for 2021-2022. To the extent Pure Water Monterey seeks to charge an amount in excess of the approved \$1,720 AF soft-cap, California American Water will be required to file a separate Tier 2 advice letter seeking approval of the higher rate.³ California American Water will continue to work with the public agencies to obtain the information needed to support the projected Company Water Rate for FY 2020-21.⁴

At this time, California American Water is only seeking to establish the Company Water Rate at \$1,720 per AF, which is within the soft cap approved by the Commission in D.16-09-021. Increases in rates charged by Monterey Peninsula Water Management District result in a \$6,020,000 annual increase in purchased water expenses to California American Water's Monterey Main Service Area, plus a corresponding \$30,948.82 increase in uncollectibles, for a total expense increase of \$6,050,949. This increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate.

The resulting increase is a surcharge of \$1.5846 per hundred cubic feet (ccf) or \$0.2118 per hundred gallons (cgl).

The offset requested represents an annual increase of \$6,050,949 or 8.65% over the latest revenue requirement approved by the Commission in the 2020 Central Division Step Rate Filing (AL 1271).

Request:

California American Water Company requests authorization to implement a purchased water surcharge totaling \$1.5846 per ccf (\$0.2118 per 100 gallons) for Monterey Main Service Area customers.

Tier Designation:

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests an effective date on or about August 10, 2020.

Notice:

Notice is not required prior to the effective date per General Order 96B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(7). California American Water will provide notice of the increase with implementation of the surcharge through bill message.

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.
