## Purpose:

This advice letter filing requests recovery of intervenor compensation awarded to Salinas Valley Water Coalition.

## **Background:**

In Decision ("D.") 19-12-049, the Salinas Valley Water Coalition was awarded compensation for contribution in connection with D.18-09-017, which granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity for California American Water Company's Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project, including a 6.4 million-gallon-per-day desalination plant. In addition, the compensation is related to D.19-01-051 that denied applications for rehearing of D.18-09-017, as modified.

After issuance of D.18-09-017 and D.19-01-051, Salinas Valley Water Coalition requested intervenor compensation. In D.19-12-049, the Commission granted Salinas Valley Water Coalition's request and ordered the following:

- 1. Salinas Valley Water Coalition is awarded \$491,077.26
- 2. Within 30 days of the effective date of this decision, California-American Water Company shall pay Salinas Valley Water Coalition the total award. Payment of the award shall include compound interest at the rate earned on prime, three-month non-financial commercial paper as reported in Federal Reserve Statistical Release H.15, beginning June 18, 2019, the 75th day after the filing of Salinas Valley Water Coalition's request, and continuing until full payment is made.<sup>1</sup>

On January 31, 2020, California American Water issued a payment of \$496,798.25, which includes interest to Salinas Valley Water Coalition in accordance with D.19-12-049.

## Request:

California American Water requests authorization to bill customers a meter surcharge to recover the \$496,798.25 compensation award for the Salinas Valley Water Coalition from all customer classes in the Monterey Service Area as ordered by D.19-12-049.

- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions:
- The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
