

Purpose:

Pursuant to Section VI of General Order 96-B and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code, California American Water requests authority to offset costs resulting from the Sonoma County Water Agency's increased charges for water California American Water purchases for its Larkfield service area.

Background

California American Water Company serves approximately 2,432 customers in its Larkfield service area, which is located in the County of Sonoma. To meet the needs of those customers, California American Water purchases water from the Sonoma County Water Agency. That Agency recently increased its wholesale rates to California American Water Company from a commission authorized amount of \$922.49 to \$1,003.86 per acre-foot, effective July 1, 2015. California American Water Company requests that the full increase be offset through a surcharge to account for the annual change in purchased water costs.

The rate increase results in a \$29,063 annual increase in purchased water expense to California American Water, plus a corresponding increase of \$239 in uncollectibles, for a total expense increase of \$29,302. This increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate as a volumetric based surcharge. The resulting incremental increase is \$0.1883 per hundred cubic feet (Ccf).

The offset requested represents an increase of \$29,302 or 0.9% over the last authorized revenue requirement.

Copies of the detailed workpapers and the documents supporting this Advice Letter have been furnished to the Commission Staff, in accordance with paragraph 32 in Section C of Standard Practice U-27-W, dated May 2008. California American Water will inform its customers of this offset by including a bill text message explaining the rate change.

Tier Designation

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 filing – Expense Offset.

Effective Date

California American Water requests that the tariffs discussed above be made effective August 14, 2015, so they correspond with the wholesale water rate increase imposed by the Sonoma County Water Agency.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST1

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds² are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES³

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.
