ADVICE LETTER NO. 1419

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to General Order 96-B and Decision ("D.") 22-12-001, California-American Water Company ("California American Water") (U210W) submits for filing and review this advice letter including the tariff sheets applicable to its Southern Division which are attached hereto.

Purpose:

The purpose of this advice letter is to request Commission approval of an increase in rates of \$3,028,021 or 2.28% to offset increased purchased power and water costs in California American Water's Southern Division.

Background:

California American Water requests authority pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Water Industry Rules, Section 7.3.1, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to offset purchased water and power expenses in its Southern Division.

Purchased Water

California American Water incurs its purchased power expenses from various purveyors that supply water to California American Water's Baldwin Hills and Ventura Service Areas. California American Water incurs its purchased water expenses for these Southern Division Services Areas from the Calleguas Municipal Water District, West Basin Municipal Water District, and Water Replenishment District of Southern California. These various wholesalers have increased rates to California American Water.California American Water requests that the full increase be offset as a quantity surcharge to account for the annual change in purchased water costs.

California American Water seeks to offset increased wholesale costs from water providers in the Ventura and Baldwin Hills Service Areas of California American Water's Southern Division. For Ventura the per AF rate increases from \$1,541 to \$1,632 for Tier-1 rates, \$1,591 to \$1,841 for Tier-2 rates, \$84,460 to \$103,441 for the Readiness to Serve Charge, and \$109,946 to \$92,541 for the Capacity Reservation Charge to match the invoice California American Water received from Calleguas Municipal Water District. For Baldwin Hills the AF rate increase from \$1,510 to \$1,605 for the West Basin

Municipal Water District cost per AF, \$1,838 to \$3,806 for Capacity/Reservation Charge, \$548 to \$6,433 for the Monthly Water Service Charge, and \$387 to \$423 for the Water Replenishment Distict cost per AF to match the notice received from West Basin Municipal Water District and Water Resplishment District.

The increase to water rates results in a \$1,624,366 annual increase to purchased water expense to California American Water, plus a corresponding increase of \$8,311 in uncollectible for a total increase of \$1,632,678. The increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate. The resulting final purchased water surcharge by service area is as follows. Per Decision 21-11-018 California American Water is authorized to partially consolidate purchased water costs in its Southern Division, as agreed to in Section 4.3 of Settlement approved by D.21-11-018. Pursuant to the approved Settlement, 70% of purchased water expenses for Baldwin Hills and Ventura would be consolidated into the Southern Division and 30% would remain within the applicable District.

Purchased Power

The composite purchased power cost factors of \$0.1733 per kilowatt-hour (kwh) and \$0.131 per kwh were established for the Ventura and Los Angeles Districts of the Southern Division in D.21-11-018. Actual composite costs per kwh for the 12-month period ending June 30, 2023 were \$0.3165 per kwh and \$0.2092 per kwh for the Ventura and Los Angeles Districts respectively. The increase to power rates results in a \$1,388,465 annual increase to purchased water expense to California American Water, plus a corresponding increase of \$7,104 in uncollectible for a total increase of \$1,395,569 for the consolidated Southern Division. The increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate. The resulting final purchased power surcharge by service area is as follows.

Request:

California American Water requests authorization to implement (1) a purchased water surcharge totaling \$0.0696 per ccf (\$0.0093 per 100 gallons) for Duarte, San Marino, San Diego, and Bellflower Service Area customers, (2) a surcharge totaling \$0.1402 per ccf (\$0.0187 per 100 gallons) for Baldwin Hills Service Area customers, and (3) a surcharge totaling \$0.1482 per ccf (\$0.0198 per cgl) for Ventura Service Area customers. California American Water requests authorization to implement apurchased power surcharge totaling \$0.0850 per ccf (\$0.0114 per 100 gallons) for the Southern Division.

Tier Designation:

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests an effective date of August 27, 2023.

Notice & Service List:

California American Water will notify its customers of this production expense by placing a message on the customer's water bills that are generated after the increase goes into effect. A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

- 5. Per Advice Letter 1380 and D.21-11-018 a surcharge of \$0.0999 per cgl will be collected from customers, Bellflower customers excluded, for the 2019 General Rate Case interim rate true-up. The surcharge will be collected until December 31, 2023.
- 6. Per Advice Letter 1409 and D.21-11-018 a surcharge/surcredit is included to recover the net under/over-collection in the WRAM and MCBA of \$2,800,803 including interest, as of December 31, 2022. The surcharge of \$0.0210 per 100 gallons is set to recover the undercollection at a rate equal to 15% of the authorized revenue requirement as approved by D.21-11-018. Bellflower customers are excluded from this surcharge.
