#### Purpose:

The purpose of this advice letter filing is to correct the Consolidated Expense Balancing Account (CEBA) surcharge/credit on previously approved advice letter 53-S.

Advice letter 53-S implementing California American Water 2018 GRC tariffs, was filed on March 13, 2019 changing the base rates and the CEBA surcharge for the Monterey Wastewater Passive Sewer Service tariff. It was approved on April 25, 2019.

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- (2) The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
