Purpose:

The purpose of this advice letter filing is to update and correct the Active Sewer tariff rates to reflect the Advice Letter 54-S 2019 Step Rate filing, which were inadvertently changed during the filing of Advice Letter 58-S.

Background:

Monterey Wastewater 2019 Step Rate Advice Letter 54-S was approved and effective May 11, 2019 and Advice Letter 58-S updating the CEBA surcharge was approved and effective September 22, 2019. The tariffs in 58-S should have reflected the rates from 54-S, but were inadvertently taken from the prior approved advice letter, 53-S.

Request:

This advice letter filing is to request a correction to Monterey Wastewater Active Sewer rates and the Low-Income Ratepayer Assistance Program surcharge.

Tier Designation:

This advice letter is submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and D.18-12-021 and is designated as a Tier 1 filing.

Effective Date:

California American requests an effective date of January 23, 2020.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST¹

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds² are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- (2) The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

DWA must receive a response or protest via email (<u>or</u> postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, <u>please include the utility name and</u> advice letter number in the subject line.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
