Purpose:

By this advice letter, California American Water requests authorization to revise its Monterey Wastewater tariffs. The changes are:

- Add the following tariffs:
 - o Create new Schedule SP sheets (1-2) to replace sheets (5-6).
- Delete the following tariffs:
 - Sheets (SP 5 and 6) are being deleted and consolidated with existing sheets (262-S and 263-S).
- Modify the following tariffs:
 - o Changed "LIRAP" acronym to "LIRA" to be consistent with other tariffs.
 - Updated CEBA rate in Schedule SP tariff sheet which was inadvertently not updated with the previously approved and properly billed rate.

The above changes do not impact authorized rates and all customers were billed correctly with respect to the modification addressed above.

Background:

In an effort to maintain accurate tariffs, California American Water will continuously review its tariffs to identify tariffs that need to be added, deleted and modified.

Request:

California American Water is requesting authorization to update the Monterey Waste Water District Tariff Area as set forth above.

Tier Designation:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No.96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 filing.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests an effective date of April 28, 2020.

- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
