ADVICE LETTER NO. 75-S

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California-American Water Company (California American Water) (U210W) submits this advice letter, including the following attached tariffs applicable to all districts:

Purpose:

California American Water requests implementation of new rates based on the revised cost of capital authorized in D.23-06-025 and the additional adjustments to the cost of capital triggered by the Water Cost of Capital Mechanism ("WCCM"), as approved via Advice Letter 1415 ("AL 1415").

Background:

Decision 23-06-025 Authorizing a Revised Cost of Capital

The Commission issued D.23-06-025 on June 29, 2023 which continued California American Water's Water Cost of Capital Mechanism ("WCCM")¹ and authorized a 8.98% return on equity ("ROE") and a 4.35% cost of debt with a 42.96% debt to 57.04% equity ratio resulting in a 6.99% return on rate base for the calendar years 2022, 2023, and 2024.²

Ordering Paragraphs 5 and 6 of D.23-06-025 provide the following:

- 5. California-American Water Company, California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, and San Jose Water Company shall each file a Tier 1 advice letter to implement rate changes to reflect the change in the cost of capital adopted herein.
- 6. All advice letters required in Ordering Paragraph 5 shall be filed within 30 days of the date of this order, the rate changes to reflect the change in the cost of capital shall be effective on the date of the filing subject to the determination by the Division of Water and Audits that the advice letters are in compliance with this decision.

This advice letter is filed in compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 5 and 6.

Commission Approval of AL 1415 Requesting WCCM Trigger

On June 30, 2023, consistent with D.23-06-025, California American Water filed AL 1415 requesting authorization to trigger the WCCM and adjust its ROE to 9.50% and its cost of debt to 4.28%, for an overall rate of return of 7.26%. California American Water subsequently received notice from Water Division on July 25 that AL 1415 was approved.

Revenue Impacts and Rates

AL 1415 provided a preliminary assessment of revenue impacts as a result of D.23-06-025 and the WCCM. Final revenue impacts and rates are included in this Advice Letter filing, which incorporates authorizations received pursuant to D.23-06-025 and AL 1415. This results in a reduction of -\$9,000 or -0.2% for the Monterey Wastewater service area and a reduction of -\$623,000 or -0.8% for the Northern Division in which Dunnigan Wastewater is included.

Request:

California American Water requests authorization to implement new rates consistent with D.23-06-025, including the impacts of the WCCM as filed in approved AL 1415.

Tier Designation:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No.96-B and this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests an effective date of July 31, 2023.

- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or

- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
